Terms & Conditions and Retained Rights

General

Authors and/or their employers retain all proprietary rights in any process, procedure, or article of manufacture described in the Work.

Authors/employers/funding agencies may reproduce or authorize others to reproduce the Work, material extracted verbatim from the Work, or derivative works for the author's personal use or for company use, provided that the source and the **EAS** copyright notice are indicated, the copies are not used in any way that implies **EAS** endorsement of a product or service of any employer, and the copies themselves are not offered for sale.

Although authors are permitted to re-use all or portions of the Work in other works, this does not include granting third-party requests for reprinting, republishing, or other types of re-use. The **EAS** Intellectual Property Rights office must handle all such third-party requests.

Authors whose work was performed under a grant from a funding agency are free to fulfil any deposit mandates from that funding agency.

Authors recognize that the payment of an Article Processing Charge is a requirement of open access publishing with **EAS**. Article processing charges may be waived in cases of hardship.

Author Online Use of Open Access Articles

Personal Servers. Authors, their employers and/or their funding agencies shall have the right to post the final, published version of **EAS** - copyrighted articles on their own personal servers or the servers of their institutions or employers without permission from **EAS**, provided that the posted version includes a prominently displayed **EAS** copyright notice and, when published, a full citation to the original **EAS** publication, including the article's Digital Object Identifier (DOI).

Classroom or Internal Training Use. An author is expressly permitted to post any portion of the final, published version of his/her own **EAS** - copyrighted articles on the author's personal web site or the servers of the author's institution or company in connection with the author's teaching, training, or work responsibilities, provided that the appropriate copyright, credit, and reuse notices appear prominently with the posted material. Examples of permitted uses are lecture materials, course packs, e-reserves, conference presentations, or in-house training courses.

Electronic Preprints. Before submitting an article to an **EAS** publication, authors frequently post their manuscripts to their own web site, their employer's site, or to another server that invites constructive comment from colleagues. Upon submission of an article to **EAS**, an author is required to transfer copyright in the article to **EAS**, and the author must update any previously posted version of the article with a prominently displayed **EAS** copyright notice. Upon publication of an article by the **EAS**, the author must replace any previously posted electronic versions of the article with either (1) the full citation to the **EAS** work with a Digital Object Identifier (DOI) or link to the article.

Warranties

Author warrants that the Contribution is original except for such excerpts from copyrighted works (including illustrations, tables, animations and text quotations) as may be included with the permission of the copyright holder thereof, in which case(s) Author is required to obtain written permission to the extent necessary and to indicate the precise sources of the excerpts in the manuscript. Author is also requested to store the signed permission forms and to make them available to **EAS** if required. Author warrants that he/she is entitled to grant the rights in accordance with "General", that he/she has not assigned such rights to third parties, that the Contribution has not heretofore been published in whole or in part, that the Contribution contains no libellous statements and does not infringe on any copyright, trademark, patent, statutory right or proprietary right of others, including rights obtained through licenses; and that Author will indemnify **EAS** against any costs, expenses or damages for which **EAS** may become liable as a result of any breach of this warranty.

Information for Readers on the Use of Open Access Articles

Reuse: Third-party users may view, print, copy and download the content for personal use or academic purposes. Users may also post links to the published **EAS** version of the Work, including the Digital Object Identifier (DOI), for their own non-commercial use. All third-party users must provide complete attribution to both the **EAS** publication title and the names of the author(s) of the Work. To copy otherwise, or to distribute/display the Work by third parties, requires the permission of **EAS**.

Reserved Rights of EAS: **EAS** reserves the right to limit the production of derivative works and commercial exploitation of the Work. Should a third party seek to make a derivative work based on the Work or commercially exploit the Work they must seek permission from **EAS**.

Text and Data Mining/Translation Rights: Non-commercial translations as well as text and data mining of the Work are permitted.
